ORDER

¶1 Mason Spencer Weiss has filed an application for admission to the practice of law in the State of Oklahoma pursuant to Rule Two of the Rules Governing Admission to the Practice of Law in the State of Oklahoma (RGAP), 5 O.S. Supp. 2018, ch.1, app. 5. The Board of Bar Examiners of the State of Oklahoma filed its Report and Recommendation finding that Mason Spencer Weiss should be admitted to the practice of law in the Oklahoma Supreme Court and all inferior courts of the State of Oklahoma.

¶2 From this Court's review of the Board of Bar Examiners' Report and Recommendation, its attached documents, and other information, this Court finds that the applicant, Mason Spencer Weiss has served in the JAG Corps in reciprocal states for the past 7 years, and was licensed in a reciprocal state during that entire time. This Court finds that Weiss has met all the requirements for admission on motion to the practice of law in the Oklahoma Supreme Court and all inferior courts of the State of Oklahoma under Rule Two of the RGAP.

¶3 It is therefore ordered that Mason Spencer Weiss be admitted to the practice of law in the Oklahoma Supreme Court and all inferior courts upon taking the oath required by Rule 1, RGAP, and signing the Roll of Attorneys in the office of the Clerk of this Court.
